Release Notes 18.01.02 Introduction

Introduction

AOS version 18.01.02 is a maintenance release that addresses customer issues that were uncovered in previous code releases.

This release is generally available code. Results obtained during internal testing have been evaluated and the code has been determined to be ready for general availability. Caveats discovered during testing but not addressed in this build are listed in *Errata on page 5*.

Features and Enhancements

Fixes

This section highlights major bug fixes in AOS version 18.01.02.

- Issuing the command clear sip resources would cause the ADTRAN unit to reboot.
- ICMP errors received over a VPN tunnel would cause a memory leak which would eventually cause the ADTRAN unit to reboot.
- The ADTRAN unit would not return information about interface **eth 0/1** when queried by SNMP.
- The default IP MTU on VLAN interfaces could not be changed.
- Adding a new IPSec Policy from the GUI would result in an error.
- Changing a VPN Peer's PFS Group from the GUI would result in an error.
- Issuing the command **show lldp neighbor** would cause the ADTRAN unit to reboot.
- The ADTRAN unit would return incomplete SNMP information when queried.
