



AOS Versioning Changes

After AOS 16, AOS data products and voice products use different versioning schemes for their new feature releases. This document will explain how the new versioning schemes work.

Data Products

- **ww.xx.yy.zz**
 - ww is the major major version number. It will only be incremented when very large features are added.
 - xx is the major version number. It will be incremented for feature releases.
 - yy is the minor version number. It is incremented for maintenance releases.
 - zz is used internally. It will always be 00 for released code.

- **Example**
 - AOS 17.01.01.00 was the first feature release under the new versioning scheme.
 - AOS 17.01.02.00 and 17.01.03.00 are maintenance releases for the 17.01 feature release. No new features were added in these releases.
 - AOS 17.02.01.00 will be the next feature release.
 - AOS 18.01.01.00 may occur in the future when a major feature is added.

Voice Products

- **wx.yy.zz**
 - w is the major major version letter. It will only be incremented when very large features are added.
 - x is the major version number. It will be incremented for feature releases.
 - yy is the minor version number. It is incremented for maintenance releases.
 - zz is used internally. It will always be 00 for released code.

- **Example**
 - AOS A1.01.00 was the first feature release under the new versioning scheme.
 - AOS A1.02.00 and A1.03.00 are maintenance releases for the A1 feature release.
 - AOS A2.01.00 will be the next feature release.
 - AOS B1.01.00 may occur in the future when a major feature is added.
