- Disconnect all power cables prior to removal of the power supply.

## REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- Disconnect all power cords from the power supply.
- 2. Loosen the screws on either side of the power supply using a screwdriver.
- 3. Remove the power supply from the NetVanta base unit by pulling on the tab that protrudes from the bottom edge of the power supply.
- 4. Being careful to align the new power supply with the card guides, slide it into the slot until it is firmly positioned against the chassis. Do not use excessive force. If you encounter resistance, remove the power supply and try again.
- Tighten the screws on either side of the power supply with a screwdriver. Hand tightening is not sufficient.
- 6. Reconnect the power cord(s).
